17 years old. A shipyard employee on Aug. 6, 1945.

She happened to be in the countryside on that day. A few days later, she entered the city to find a friend.



Shoso HIRAI

16 years old. 4th year student at merchant school on Aug. 6, 1945.

He was in the Northern area of Hiroshima (4 km) Visiting his friend.



Keiko OGURA

8 years old. An elementary school girl, 2nd grade on Aug. 6, 1945.

She was in the Northern area of Hiroshima (2.4 km) On the street near her house.
